The tour schedule is:

Parking and pickup for guests will be at **Keyport Undersea Museum** parking lot.

0930 - Bus will arrive at the **Keyport Undersea Museum** parking lot to meet & greet guests, hand out security badges, & depart for the Trident Training Facility (TTF).

1000 - Arrive at TTF. Commence walking tour.

1130 - TTF tour complete. Bus departs for the Inside Out Café or Galley (lunch).

1140 - Arrive Inside Out Café or Galley.

1230 - Board bus and depart for Delta pier.

1300 - Arrive Delta pier for submarine tour.

1430 - Submarine tour complete. Depart for Keyport.

1500 - Arrive Keyport and drop off Guests.

Lunch at the Inside Out Café is \$6.00 to \$10.00.

The minimum age is 11 years old. All guests over the age of 16 must present a state or government issued photo identification. Guests between 11 and 16 do not require a photo ID but are strongly recommended to bring a copy of their birth certificate or other photo identification. ID's must be available throughout the entire visit.

NO firearms, knives, or weapons of any kind are permitted.

NO Alcohol or flammable substances are permitted.

NO PHOTOGRAPHIC capable devices are permitted.

NO electronic devices to include cell phones are permitted.

Only health and medical related electronic devices are permitted. All guests should be able to climb up and down a thirty foot vertical ladder. All guests should be in good health mentally and physically. Those prone to claustrophobia or panic attacks should not attend submarine tours. The dress code is uniform of the day for military personnel. Civilian guests should wear closed toe shoes, jeans or slacks - no skirts or dresses allowed. No political or offensive clothing (T-shirts) is permitted.
